



Fredericton Arts Alliance – School Grants for 2018-2019

ASD-W is happy to partner once again with the Fredericton Arts Alliance (FAA) for the 2018-2019 school year. The FAA makes available grants to Capital Region schools, to collaborate with local artists to work with students, to produce cross-curricular projects of artistic merit in Visual Art, Music, Drama, Multi-Media and Dance. Through the project, students will have the opportunity to understand the Arts as offering career path opportunities.

2018-2019 features some small changes to the application process, and project expectations. Please read carefully.

Projects are expected to benefit an entire class of students in an immersive art experience. Artists will receive a \$600 Honorarium to work with a teacher and their class of students for 15 to 25 hours.

Mileage will be reimbursed, however, in order to maximize the number of grants that can be awarded, schools are asked to work with artists in their local communities.

Likewise, while the grant application can request funds for project materials, in order to benefit as many schools as possible, using school based tools, or borrowing tools as necessary is encouraged.

The Fredericton Arts Alliance is happy to work as medium to connect schools and artists. Feel free to reach out, if you would like suggestions of artists in your community.

When the final projects are ready for celebration, it is customary to invite members of the Fredericton Arts Alliance to view and celebrate alongside the school.

The application form is attached. Project applications will be vetted by committee, and awarded on the basis of artistic merit, curricular value, and mindful of the total funds available.
